夢想的實際意義

人的一生,窮盡一切,都是為了自己的夢想而付諸行動。有些夢想在別人看來遙不可及,不切實際,但是別人固有的想法或者觀點是阻止不了你追夢的。只要心中有夢,必能仰擎星空。因此,看似不切實際的夢想,其實很有意義。

在實現夢想的道路上,總是幾經周折,困難重重,使人垂頭喪氣,覺得夢 想望塵莫及,甚至是不可能實現的事;在表面上,夢想看似不切實際,可是 對個人成長很有意義。十年前,網上流傳了一則博文,叫做「寒門再難出貴 子」, 意即生於貧窮家庭的孩子是不能成為追夢者。可是在現實中, 寒門逆襲 的例子比比皆是。外國有個叫尼克的小男孩出生在貧民區,家庭經濟條件很 差,連基本的溫飽都成問題,但是他從小的夢想就是入讀哈佛大學。在三餐不 繼的情況下,談夢想簡直是癡人説夢,非常不切實際。但是尼克打心底從未想 過放棄這個夢想,他日以繼夜地在社區中心埋頭苦練,通宵達日地與書為友, 憑藉自己的努力及持之以恆,成功在19歲那年考進哈佛大學,其後改讀博十學 位留校任教。命運看似不能自主,實則掌握在自己手中;夢想看似不切實際, 其實很有意義。對於尼克來説,實現夢想的意義是命運給他了一個較別人低的 「起跑線」,是他用一生的努力來的努力收獲美味的「果實」。這個夢想是關 於堅毅,關於自主學習,關於拼搏;這個夢想是有志者,事竟成,破釜沈舟, 百二秦關終屬楚;這個夢想不是水到渠成的童話故事;這個夢想是苦心人,天 不負,臥薪嘗膽,三千越甲可吞吳。夢想不切實際,離你有四萬八千里之遠, 但是只腳踏實地,一步一步,最終便會到達。所以夢想是有意義的。

宏觀來看,實現社會改革的夢想更是艱難險阻,看似不合實際,其實很有意義。來自巴基斯坦的女孩馬拉拉有一個微小的夢想:令所有的女性都擁有接受教育的權力。這在旁人眼中當然不切實際——巴基斯坦當時被塔利班控制,女性被禁止上學和就業、女性被迫停課。在根涤蒂固的保守思想影響下,加上塔利班的武裝威脅,一個女孩又怎能空談要女性獲得教育?然而,馬拉拉沒有

放棄,她在部落格上書寫著自己對上學的強烈渴望,在國內外進行了不同規模的演講,即使被暴徒襲擊,仍然無畏地向全世界宣言自己的理想。在國內外的輿論壓力下,巴基斯坦政府終於踏出第一步,進行教育改革。就是這麼一個小女孩的「天真」夢想,通過她勇於表達立場及不畏懼任何恐嚇事件,使巴基斯坦的女性能夠開闢教育之路,甚至渲染了那些認為前景渺茫、膽小怕事的人,令他們開始嘗試爭取自己應有的權利。若不是馬拉拉,巴基斯坦的女性的命運終不會變。這不正正是追尋夢想的真正意義所在嗎?

民族層面,實現國家之大的夢想就如削足適履,實則很有意義。孫中山先生年輕時的夢想就是推翻滿清,建立共和,而這在當時來說並不符合實際一中國兩千年多年來都是朝代更替、君主集權,「家天下」的制度牢不可破,人民也長期習慣於受君主統治,豈能說推翻就推翻?但孫中山先生憑著一股衝勁,積極地宣傳及籌募經費,又組織革命黨以建立雄厚的勢力,並發動多次起義以累積戰鬥經驗。「功夫不負有心人」,革命黨終於在辛亥革命中,以看似微不足道的戰鬥力,攻陷了各大城市,成功推翻了滿清政府以及君主集權制。孫中山先生曾經被看作為荒謬至極、螳臂當車的夢想最終卻令革命黨人前夫後續,成就了中華民國的誕生,為中國人民開創了新天地。甚是充滿意義。

很多人認為,不切實際的夢想是毫無意義的。但事實上,他們只是被固有成見或個人狹隘的思維所蒙蔽,忽略了微不足道的夢想所散發的意義所在。我憶起馬丁·路德金曾說過:「我有一個夢想。」那個夢想是廢除黑奴的制度,創造一個種族平等、人民友愛的社會。但當時他的提議遭受到大多數白人反對,由於白人深怕他們本來擁有的利益受損,更害怕實行後,他們將失去至高無上的社會地位。因此對於馬丁·路德金的說法堅決否定,並一直妨礙進度,令馬丁·路德金實現種族平等的理想變得如同泡沫般,一碰即破。但馬丁·路德金從未有過放棄的念頭,不屈不撓,最終美國實行並通過了《反黑人歧視



法》。至此不難發現,那些讓我們放棄夢想的因素,不過於自己的空想罷了。 而那些毫無顧慮的人們,總是抱有赤子之心,因此總能發現每個夢想背後的真 正意義。

夢想,反映每個人內心最執狂的理想和最真摯的渴求。它往往不切實際, 天馬行空,但若你擯棄所有的不安和疑慮,用心實現理想,便會了解到夢想其 實很有意義。從今開始,你願意放手追夢嗎?

I stood up and tried to rush out of the treatment room but a nurse in white pushed my shoulders down. "Tik tok, tik tok......" I was waiting for the hour hand to point to figure "3".

That's a scene of my treatment. I was diagnosed with ADHD (attention deficit hyperactivity disorder) at 10. If you don't know what it means, picture a kid physically leaping from table to table when she gets frustrated or excited. She would scream, climb onto things, slam the door and run around the classroom whenever her spirits soared.

Sitting down was the worst part of the treatment. There were three other patients who were the same age as me. I knew their stories. Tom, a boy with autism, stayed in his seat silently. He arched his back like a shrimp and his toes were as tight as a ballet dancer. The quiet shy boy wanted to be a talk show actor. The depressed girl, Anna, used to be a straight A student. She aspired to become a doctor, but she suffered a severe mental illness. She once nearly dug out her left eyeball with her bare hands. I stared at her brown eyes which were filled with tenderness. I thought she would be a good doctor. Kelly, a girl, kept writing sticky notes. She told us that her bedroom was covered by thousands of sticky notes and the index cards were scattered on her desk, the couch and even her bed. Her dream was to say "Objection" soberly in court.



As for me, I built up a magic world in my brain, a world that may only exist in fictional stories like Harry Potter. Leaping from table to table was just because I saw sparrows jumping among the branches. That's quite interesting, so I tried it. I wished my friends could appreciate my nice attempt, but I was mocked as a psycho who needed to be sent to the hospital.

My treatment, or it is more like training, was "weird". The best part was the nurses gave an order and let us act the opposite order accordingly. For example, if the order is to take a step forward, we should take a step back. I don't really understand the principle of this game, but I like this feeling—a feeling of violating rules.

I like the feeling of resistance, so I began to do something that others never believed I could do-writing.

Soon I came to write, filling up ruled paper with words, standing against the wall. With ADHD, I could not sit down properly at all. Ten minutes was my limit. However I found myself much better when focusing on writing. I spared no effort to restrain my feet from moving and bouncing. My hands were shaking so my handwriting was awful; mercifully, I successfully squeezed all these strong passions and imagination from my brain into a notebook. At that moment, I experienced a profound peace, one that would always make me associate writing with liberation and healing.

Perhaps ADHD was a superpower. It allowed me to write so fast with huge enthusiasm and endless creativity. Hundreds of pages were filled with my handwriting. My new friends there, Tom, Anna and Kelly, were the main characters in my fiction. We were different from other children; we struggled to do the things we like even though it seemed like mission impossible. "You'll be a good writer." They encouraged me.

Although I was still not able to sit for more than 30 minutes, I could at least stand. That was kooky. I could stand for a few hours. The doctor told me that I would be a good writer after my last treatment.

Now I have graduated from college. Kelly texts me that she is preparing to obtain a lawyer license. Tom won a prize in a speech competition. Anna found a job in St. Joseph's Hospital. We share an unspoken belief—resisting anything that hinders you to chase your dream, even if it's a tough job.
